Code of Conduct for Parents/Carers of Young Golfers

As parents you are expected to:

- Positively reinforce your child and show an interest in their chosen activity
- Do not place your child under pressure or push them in to activities they do not want to do
- Be realistic and supportive
- Promote your child's participation in playing sport for fun
- Complete and return the Player Profile Form and Consents pertaining to your child's participation in activities at **NLCGA**
- Report and update **NLCGA** with any changes relevant to your child's health and wellbeing
- Deliver and collect your child punctually before and after coaching sessions/competitions
- Ensure your child has clothing and kit appropriate to the weather conditions
- Ensure your child has appropriate equipment, plus adequate food and drink
- Ensure your child has any required medication with them
- Ensure that you child understands the rules of Golf
- Teach your child that they can only do their best
- Ensure that your child understands their Code of Conduct
- Behave responsibly at **NLCGA** and on the golf course; do not embarrass your child
- Show appreciation and support the coaches, volunteers and staff at **NLCGA**
- Accept the decision and judgement of the officials during events and competition

As a parents/carer you have the right to:

- Be assured that your child is safeguarded during their participation in the sport
- Be informed of problems or concerns relating to your child
- Be informed if your child is injured
- Have consent sought for issues such as trips and photography
- Contribute to the decisions of the county
- Have any concerns about any aspect of your child's welfare listened and responded to

Any breaches of this code of conduct will be dealt with immediately by the CJO at **NLCGA**. Persistent concerns or breaches may result in you being asked not to attend games if your attendance is considered detrimental to the welfare of young participants.

The ultimate action should a parent/carer continue to breach the code of conduct may be the **NLCGA** regrettably asking your child to leave the session, event or county team.
